	Quote approval: Obtain client approval on pricing to avoid unnecessary template setup.
	Artwork requirements: Get artwork specifications from the trade-printer.

	Receive artwork from client: InDesign Package (preferred), Illustrator, or PDF.
H	Quality check: Ensure content is free of typos and errors.
	Print-Ready confirmation: Send finalized artwork to printer for readyness approval.

	Variable elements: Determine which design elements are variable and which are mandatory.
	Design adjustments: Plan for how design elements may shift if optional inputs are missing.
	Special features: Decide on the need for QR codes, multiple design options, etc.
	Add carrot Tags: Indicate variable elements in the artwork using tags (e.g., <city>, <state>).</state></city>

	Project submission: Use a clear subject line (e.g., "ACME Business Cards"). Provide a video
	overview of template requirements. Attach artwork assets and customization directions.
	Cost estimate: Request a cost estimate before starting development.
	E-commerce admin access: Create an admin user for Coverdale to build products in your platform.
	Development approval: Give Coverdale the green light to start template development.

	Review in e-commerce platform: Test various scenarios to ensure everything works correctly.
\neg	Proof and production files: Download files and confirm print-readiness with your printer.
\neg	Client testing: Have the client test the customization process.
\neg	Final approval: Obtain final approval from the client on the template.
